For example, if your total tax liability on your return is \$1,000 but you claim a \$500 tax credit, your net liability drops to \$500.

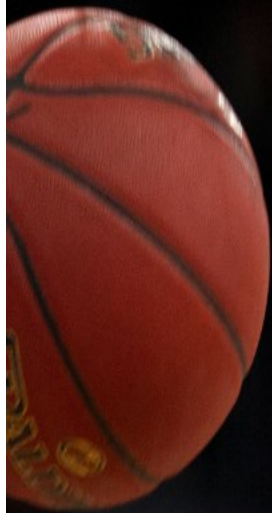
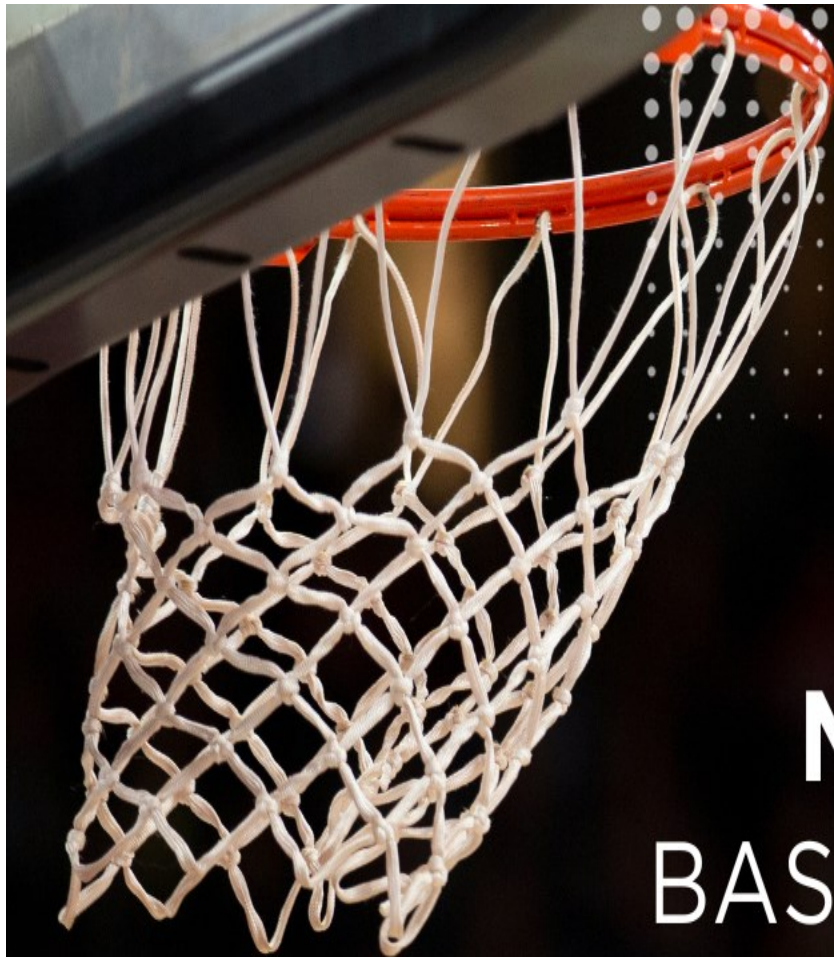
